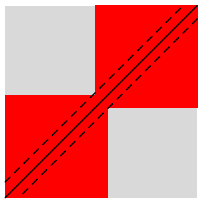


Block 4 - Star

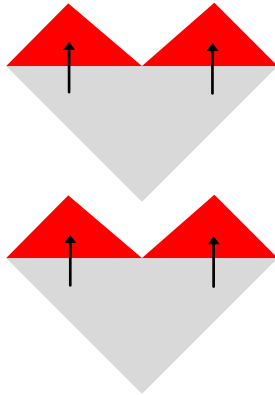
Making the star points: 4 at a time Flying Geese

Cut (1) 7 1/4" WOF strip of white - Subcut (3) 7 1/4" squares

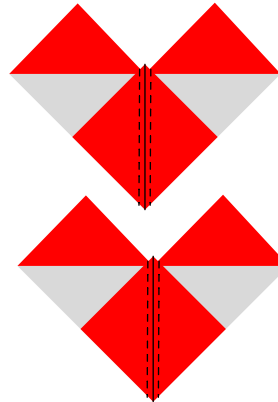
Cut (2) 3 7/8" WOF strips of red fabric - Subcut (12) 3 7/8" squares



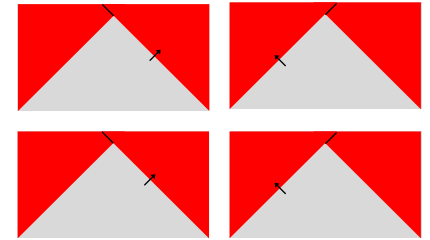
Place (2) red squares onto (1) white square. Draw a line from corner to corner across the red squares. Stitch 1/4" on each side. Cut on drawn line.



Press towards the red triangles.



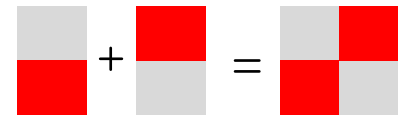
Add the remaining red squares as shown. Draw a line. Stitch 1/4" on each side and cut on drawn line.



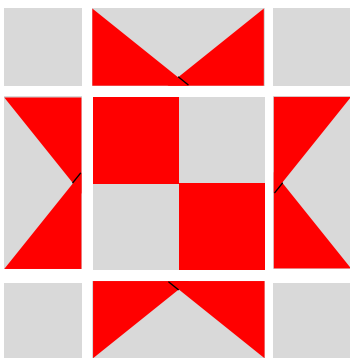
Press towards the red.

Finishes at 3.5" x 6.5".

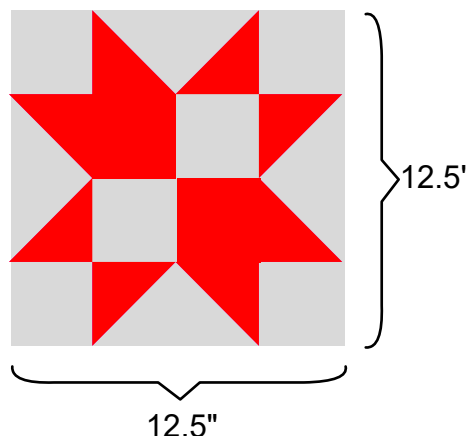
Cut (1) 3.5" x WOF strip of red & (2) 3.5" x WOF strips of white. Subcut (12) 3.5" pieces from the white strips for corner pieces. Piece the red and the remaining white strip together lengthwise. Press seam towards the red. Subcut (6) 3.5" pieces



Flip every second piece and sew them together into sets of two creating three 6.5" 4-patch centre blocks.



Arrange the pieces as per the diagram. Sew them together into rows then piece the rows together.
