

Tips for Successful Walking Foot Quilting

- Ensure you have the right foot for your machine
 - Consult a dealer
- Install the walking foot properly
 - Refer to the manual
- Good basting = good results
 - Many good videos on YouTube
- Test the walking foot and adjust if needed
 - Stitch on a small quilt sandwich
 - Refer to your manual to adjust presser foot pressure
 - Adjust stitch length and/or tension
 - Slow down
- Use an open toe sole
 - Allows for visibility
- Choose the right design according to
 - Experience
 - Quilt size
 - Time available
 - Purpose of the quilt
 - Physical ability
- When following a Walking Foot Quilting Design Pattern
 - Allow for the 1/4" seam allowance on the edge of the quilt as it will be covered by binding after quilting is complete
